

Eligibility for Certificate in Higher Education and Diploma in Higher Education :
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Award Criteria

A student is eligible for the award of a Certificate of Higher Education (Cert HE) provided that they have:

- a) achieved an overall average of 40% over 120 credits in Part 1 , where all the credits are at Level 4 or above; AND
- b) achieved a mark of at least 30% in individual modules amounting to not less than 100 credits taken in Part 1.

A Cert HE award does not include a classification.

Standard Programme Learning Outcomes for Cert HE

Students who achieve a Cert HE have demonstrated :

Diploma of Higher Education

Award Criteria

A student is eligible for the award of a Diploma of Higher Education (Dip HE) provided that they have:

- a) achieved an overall average of 40% over 120 credits in Part 2, where at least 100 credits are at Level 5 or above ; AND
- b) achieved a mark of at least 40% in 80 credits taken in Part 2, and a mark of at least 30% in 120 credits in Part 2
